




ATRIBUTE TO MONDOG



A VISUAL REQUIEM

Blending **four perspectives into a single drawing**—each inspired by a Moondog composition. Influenced by George Condo's explorations of mental states, the piece dissolves boundaries between emotion, sound, and form.

With each rotation, a new song emerges, echoing the fluid, deconstructed essence of Fog on the Hudson, Frost Flower, Rimshot, and Dog Trot. This work is both homage and dialogue, reflecting the avant-garde spirit of the Viking of 6th Avenue and the unseen landscapes his music shapes.



This collection explores the intersection of code and sound, where algorithmic structures give rise to dynamic, evolving compositions.




